<b>Eligible Players</b>	All players of clubs affiliated through their National Associations to the BWF.
<b>Conditions of Play</b>	The tournament will be played in full accordance with the laws of Badminton and General Competition Regulations adopted by the BWF as well as the regulations of the Badminton Europe's Elite Circuit. The tournament draw sizes are limited to: (a) 100 matches per day (b) 2 rounds per event per day for the main draw (c) no more than 3 qualifying rounds for a maximum of 8 places in any event

	<p>(d) if more players/pairs enter the competition than the organisers can accept even in the qualifying rounds the World Ranking shall be used to determine the players/pairs whose entries can be accepted into the qualifying draw and which entry to fill any subsequent vacancy that may arise. Competitors must be prepared to play at the times quoted in the order of play for the events for which they were entered.</p> <p>Competitors can be scratched if not ready to play when called.</p> <p>Players shall not plan their departure less than 2 (two) hours after their last match is planned to conclude. If a player is unable to compete due to early departure, he/she shall be penalised by Forfeiture of rewards (removal of Elite Circuit ranking points and shall not be awarded prizes or prize money). Badminton Europe shall propose to BWF that the gained BWF ranking points are also removed (as in §9.5).</p> <p>The seeding and the draw will be done by Badminton Europe.</p>
<b>Scoring System</b>	Knock out system according to BWF rules.

<b>Courts</b>	5 YONEX courts
<b>Practice Courts/ Facilities</b>	<p>On 28<sup>th</sup> May 2024, 17:00 - 20:00 the courts within the venue are put at disposal free of charge. Players can practice on them without registration but should notice that there are only 5 practice courts that might be occupied.</p> <p>In addition players can practice at the VisioLife Sportsclub before or during the tournament (09:00 – 17:00, 11,-€ / court per hour; 17:00 – 22:00, 20,-€ / court per hour). <b>Entries</b>	<p>All entries must be made by using the BWF Online Entry System.</p> <p>Entries must be submitted no later than Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> April 2024 at 23:59 BWF HQ time (GMT +08.00).</p> <p>Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF ID-number. In case you wish to enter players who do not have a BWF ID-number yet, please use the Tournament Software to register new players before the closing date of the tournament.</p> <p>For online entries please use this link:  <a href="https://bwf.tournamentsoftware.com/tournament/CD585D56-CD01-4D9F-9F07-F2C731990DBF">https://bwf.tournamentsoftware.com/tournament/CD585D56-CD01-4D9F-9F07-F2C731990DBF</a></p> <p><b>No late entries will be accepted.</b></p> <p>Compliance with BWF GCR 7.9: “In making or authorising entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF’s regulations and Disciplinary processes.”</p>
<b>Entry Fees</b>	<p>Singles: 55€ per player  Doubles: 45€ per player per event</p> <p>The Member that enters a player into a BEC Elite Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. It is recommended that the entry fees are paid by bank transfer, but the organisers can accept cash payment at tournaments. The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organisers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member.</p> <p>Bank transfer information:  <b>Account owner: 1. <b>Withdrawals</b>	<p>Any withdrawal after the Monday immediately preceding the draw, for any reason whatsoever, renders the Member concerned liable to an amount of US \$150.00 for the inconvenience caused by the withdrawal (as defined in BWF General Competition Regulations) (as in §22.1).</p> <p>Any player not showing up for a match at the tournament, without having been withdrawn in advance, renders the Member concerned liable to an <u>additional</u> amount of US\$ 500,00 for the inconvenience caused by the "no show" (as defined in BWF General Competition Regulations) (as in §22.2).</p>
<b>Visas</b>	After entering player(s) in the tournament it is the Member’s responsibility to secure visas for their players – if this is needed. The Tournament Organisers will do everything possible to enable the entered players to get a visa.

	For assistance to the organisers of the visa paperwork, affected players are asked to submit the visa form at the tournament website no later than 2 <sup>nd</sup> May 2024.
<b>Minimum Amount of Entries</b>	<p>In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.1: World Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking, i.e. BEC Elite Circuit Ranking and BWF World Ranking.</p> <p>In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.1: World Ranking System, the first published version of the main draw of an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking. Badminton Europe is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings (as in §3.3).</p>
<b>Tournament Cancellation</b>	The organising Member can cancel the tournament in case of force majeure. Such cancellation must be announced at least 15 days before the start of the tournament. If a cancellation is announced less than 15 days before the start of the tournament, then the Member organising the tournament is liable for any expenses incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.). Badminton Europe is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons because of a cancellation of a tournament (as in §3.4).
<b>Prize Money</b>	There is no prize money for this tournament.
<b>Transport</b>	<p>Official points of arrival:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bonn main station</li> <li>• CGN airport</li> <li>• Train station Siegburg/Bonn</li> </ul> <p>Transport is only free of charge for players staying at the tournament hotel booked with the keyword (for accommodation booking see below).</p> <p>Transport can also be provided for other players from a point of arrival to any hotel in the city area of Bonn but is then charged as follows (pay in cash when accessing transport vehicle):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 20,-€ / player from or to one of the train stations</li> <li>• 30,-€ / player from or to CGN airport</li> </ul> <p>Coaches travelling with at least two players get free transportation from or to one of the official points of arrival.</p> <p>All players who need a transport are asked to inform us the earliest possible, but not later than 16<sup>th</sup> May by submitting the transportation form at the tournament website.</p> <p>Transportation between the tournament hotels and the venue will be via public transport (about 10 minutes) and is free of charge for players staying at the tournament hotel booked with the keyword. Tickets for the tram will be provided at the tournament hotel and are valid for the whole city area of Bonn. These tickets can also be purchased at the venue by all other players.</p> <p>For Hotel-Restaurant „Zur Post“: It is also possible to walk the 1.6km between the tournament hotel and the venue.</p>

	<p>Players who want to stay at one of the tournament hotels are asked to inform us the earliest possible by submitting the accommodation form at the tournament website. Submitting the form is a binding booking, cancellation is not free of charge. Afterwards the organiser will invoice the booking via email and with a payment request within two (2) weeks respectively before arrival.</p> <p>The number of rooms is limited. Rooms are provided 'first come, first served'.</p> <p>When booking the tournament hotel through the organiser free transport is provided (see above).</p>
<b>Clothing and Advertising Regulations</b>	<p>Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF General Competition Regulations § 20 to 24. Any breach of these regulations will be forwarded to BWF. It is mandatory that partners in doubles wear the same colour of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts at all times during play in both the qualification and the main draw. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 100,00 EUR (as in §18.2).</p>
<b>Medical</b>	<p>A physiotherapist will be present in the Sports hall during the tournament and a medical doctor will be on call.</p>
<b>Doping Control</b>	<p>Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.</p> <p>Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. <b>Badminton Integrity</b>	<p>Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.</p> <p>To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.</p> <p>Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match(es).</p> <p>For more information, please refer to BWF's website:  <a href="https://corporate.bwfbadminton.com/integrity/anti-match-fixing-overview/">https://corporate.bwfbadminton.com/integrity/anti-match-fixing-overview/</a></p>

<b>Further Information</b>	<p>The organiser will install a streaming service, so the streaming of matches on two selected courts will be possible: The links will be published on the tournament website.</p> <p>Food will be provided at the venue. There will be a cafeteria within the venue where players can purchase drinks and healthy fresh-cooked real-food.</p> <p>The organiser will provide free WiFi at the venue.</p> <p>Within the venue there will be a stringing service.</p>
<b>Data Security</b>	<p>Every player registering for the tournament consents that photo material of him or her might be taken during the event and published on the tournament website and on social media platforms. The organiser assures that publications of this material will solely be made in connection with the event.</p>
